Alternate-Wear Days These days, i.e., Jean Days, Dress Up Days, Non-Uniform Days, will be listed on the monthly school calendar. Alternate-Wear Days are meant to provide a variety in the dress code for students.

The following are not considered acceptable for wear on ANY day at Holy Trinity for students K-8:

- Denim of any kind except on Jean Days
- Clothing with inappropriate printing
- Tank tops and spaghetti strap tops, tube tops, crop tops
- Spandex shorts, excessive jewelry, inappropriate logos and language
 - Flip-flops
 - Unnatural hair color
- Hats or baseball caps (unless specified on the calendar)
