Holy Week & Easter Schedule

As we enter this most sacred time in our Church year, we invite all families to join us in prayer and celebration:

Palm Sunday (March 29–30): Masses at 5:00 PM (Saturday), 8:30 AM & 10:30 AM (Sunday)

Tuesday of Holy Week (March 31): Mass at 9:00 AM in the chapel, followed by Adoration until 8:00 PM

Wednesday of Holy Week (April 1): Mass at 9:00 AM in the church

The Paschal Triduum—the three holiest days of the Church year—begins:

Holy Thursday (April 2): Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 PM, followed by Adoration until 10:00 PM

Good Friday (April 3): Stations of the Cross at Noon; Passion of the Lord at 1:30 PM

Easter Vigil (April 4): Begins at 8:30 PM with the Service of Light

Easter Sunday: Masses at 8:30 AM & 10:30 AM
