Lent at Holy Trinity Catholic School

During the season of Lent, Holy Trinity Catholic School focuses on growing closer to God through prayer, sacrifice, and service. This sacred time helps our students live out our mission "To know, love, and serve God in all we do."

Students gather each week for school Mass, where they pray together and experience the beauty of Catholic tradition. During this Lenten season, students are learning and singing the Latin hymn "Ubi Caritas est vera" ("Where charity and love are found, God is there"), reminding us that love and kindness are at the heart of our faith.

Throughout Lent, students participate in Stations of the Cross. This year, our reflections highlight both Jesus' journey to the cross and our call to care for God's creation.
